To save lives by meeting physical needs like shelter, nutrition, and health care.


To keep children off the streets and let them know that God loves them and they are valued.

THE MOTIVATION

In 2018, 5.3 million children under 5 died. About ½ of them were from Sub Saharan Africa. Poverty, causing both undernutrition and lack of basic medical help, often means that a child dies needlessly when they don't have to. Those that survive experience stunting or wasting.

THE METHOD

A sponsor makes a one-time donation or commits to:
