Each corps has different culture and setting. Please select a program or two carefully to fit into your corps setting. **Remember, the purposes of women's programs are to help our women and girls grow in Christ, transform their lives, equip them through education, encourage them through connection, build authentic Christian fellowship, help them be engaged with social justice and action. It is IMPOSSIBLE to grow in Christ without a faith community.**

- **Bookclub:** Choose a book, Read a chapter individually, Meet each other once a week to share insights, Celebrate together when they finish the book

- **'Grow':** Grow curriculum is well made discipleship program for girls and younger women. Leader's Guide and Modules are located in the website; <https://women.saconnects.org/>
- **Bible study: RightNow Media** provides lots of online Bible studies. USA East SA officers already received a free subscription – THQ pays a lot of money for the subscription every year on behalf of you. - **Scripture Writers:** Choose a book of the Bible, Psalm is recommended to start, play a quiet music and write scriptures slowly and neatly on a notebook, writing is different than just reading, this practice will be helpful to digest God's Word little by little. You may challenge ladies to memorize and recite it.
- **Moms in Prayer:** Moms of school aged kids meet once a week to pray for their own children. Prayer tools are available on the website; <https://momsinprayer.org/group-leaders/> You can utilize all those free resources that are nicely prepared for you just to lead.
- **SA Magazine Lovers:** There are a lot of SA magazines in the corps building. A group of ladies choose a magazine, read one of articles together, share thoughts, and pray together. Coffee and refreshments may be provided.
- **Prayer Shawl Ministry:** Meet once a week, Make a list of people in need of care and love, Make shawls, scarves, blankets, hats, Place all their hands on the shawl and pray for the recipient, Write a card, Hand them over to those recipients
- **Christian Parenting:** Learn about Christian parenting through books, videos, and experienced moms, Share burdens and concerns, Pray together, Familylife's website provides "Art of parenting kit"; <https://www.familylife.com/aop/watch/> It also includes resources and study materials for Christian family
- **Prayer Walk:** A group of ladies wear comfy clothes and shoes, Meet once a week, Walk together, Pray for neighborhood while walking, Start and end with prayer
- **Proverbs 31:** Read Proverbs 31 together whenever ladies meet each other, Help and build one another to grow into godly mother and godly wife, Devotionals and Podcasts are available on the website; <https://proverbs31.org/>
- **All Green Thumbs:** Give thanks to God for the beauty of nature, Spend time with ladies for Gardening, Planting, Tips & Techniques, Beautifying the corps and the gardens of sick/suffering sisters

- **Journaling:** Learn about the beauty of journaling, Prayer Journal, Gratitude Journal, Meet once a week, Share joy and struggles of the week with one another
- **Calligraphy:** Learn calligraphy, Practice together, Write scripture verses and inspirational quotes, Share it with others
